A two day conference will be held on 30 - 31 October at the Novotel Northbeach, Wollongong to celebrate the Leadership Illawarra Program. The conference will see the graduation of 25 emerging leaders from the inaugural program, followed by the induction of the second cohort into the program.

The Leadership Illawarra Program is a two year experiential learning program for the region's emerging leaders. Through the program, participants have the opportunity to interact with and learn from today's leaders and gain practical experience working on team based projects. The Leadership Illawarra Program was developed by RDA Illawarra in conjunction with the Sydney Business School, University of Wollongong and The Illawarra Connection.

The conference will start at 7.30am on Thursday, 30 October with a breakfast session where the Executive Dean, Professor John Glynn from the University of Wollongong, Eddy De Gabriele, Chair of Regional Development Australia Illawarra and Graham Lancaster, Vice President of The Illawarra Connection will present the graduation certificates to the first cohort.
